

Nominate Your Outstanding AMVET, Auxiliary or Sons Member

A few years past, there was created specific awards for those AMVETS, Auxiliary, and Sons whose efforts have contributed significantly to the spirit of Iowa AMVETS. These awards serve to recognize those individuals who genuinely believe in the AMVETS principles. Post, Auxiliary, Sons of AMVETS and individuals are invited to make recommendations to the Awards Committee for any or all of the following Awards subject to the rules.

The purpose of these awards is to recognize AMVETS, Auxiliary members, and SONS, who perform outstanding, meritorious services that should be accorded special recognition. You are encouraged to make your recommendations and submit them to the Department Headquarters. The following awards will be announced at the Convention Banquet on Saturday night June 8, 2013.

1. Iowa AMVET of the Year
2. Iowa AMVET Post of the Year
3. Iowa AMVET Auxiliary Member or Post of the Year
4. Iowa AMVET /sons of AMVETS Member or Squadron of the Year
5. Department Commander's Special Award

Rules Pertaining to the Awards

1. Each Post, Auxiliary, Sons of AMVETS, or individual may submit an applicant for any of the awards.
2. Documents attesting to the achievements of the applicant (Post, Auxiliary, Sons of AMVETS, or Individual) must be submitted. These documents can be newspaper clippings, brochures, or any material supporting the applicant. Applications will be judged solely on what was done to "Help Build AMVETS".
3. The recommendations must be submitted to Department Headquarters 5826 Caldwell Road, Coggon Iowa 52218 by June 1st, 2013.
4. All applicants must be members of AMVETS, Auxiliary, or Sons of AMVETS in good standing.
5. The contents of the applications must be authenticated by the Post Commander, Auxiliary President, or Squadron Commander signature stating that he or she has knowledge of the foregoing achievements and that they are true and correct. In the event the Post Commander, Auxiliary President, or Sons commander is the nominee, the Adjutant or Secretary may endorse the application.
6. Decision of the AMVETS Awards Committee shall be final.
7. In the event that more than one applicant should be ruled equally eligible for the same award, duplicate awards will be presented.
8. Presentation of awards will be made at the State Commander's, Auxiliary President, and Sons of AMVETS Commander's Banquet during the State convention.
